- 5. You'll see four open-ended fields:
 - What should ChatGPT call you?
 - What do you do?
 - What traits should ChatGPT have?
 - Anything else ChatGPT should know about you?
- 6. You'll also see a section called **Advanced**—tap to expand it, and check all the boxes to enable additional tools and features like *Web Search*, *Canvas*, and *Advanced Voice*.
- 7. Use the examples provided below as templates or inspiration. Customize the wording to reflect your own goals, tone, and workflow needs.
